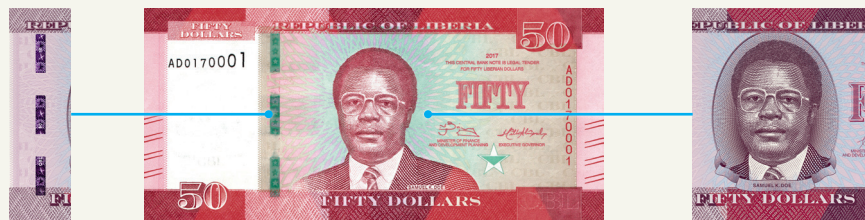

### SECURITY THREAD

Stars with pulsing effect and dynamic colour changing effect (L\$20, L\$50, L\$500 and L\$1000 with different colors). The text "CBL" and the denomination number can be seen, when held up to the light. When tilted, the thread for the L\$100 shows pulsating purple colored stars, giving the same appearance as in the 2021 issued L\$100.

### PORTRAIT / MAIN PICTURES

The denominations L\$20, L\$50 and L\$100 show a new design of the same portrait on the front side. L\$500 shows a new front picture. The back side pictures remain the same. L\$1000 is the new highest denomination showing "Sixteen tribes of Liberia" on the front side and "the Capitol building" on the back side.

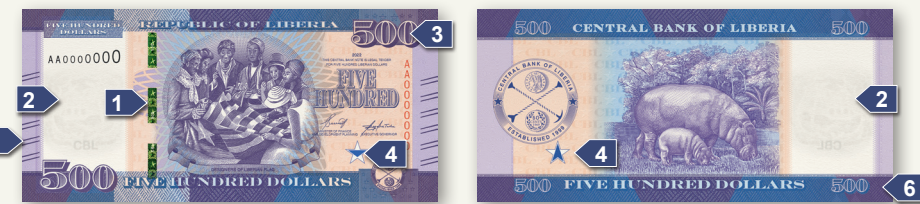

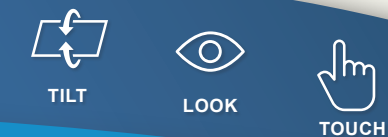

### 1 SECURITY THREAD

Stars with pulsing effect and dynamic colour changing effect (L\$20, L\$50, L\$500 and L\$1000 with different colors). The text “CBL” and the denomination number can be seen, when held up to the light. The thread for the L\$100 shows a purple colored pulsing star. It remains the same as in the 2021 issued version.



### 2 WATERMARK

When holding the note against the light, the coat of arms of Liberia and the text “CBL” are visible.



### 3 INTAGLIO

The banknote has areas with raised ink which can be felt by running the finger over it.



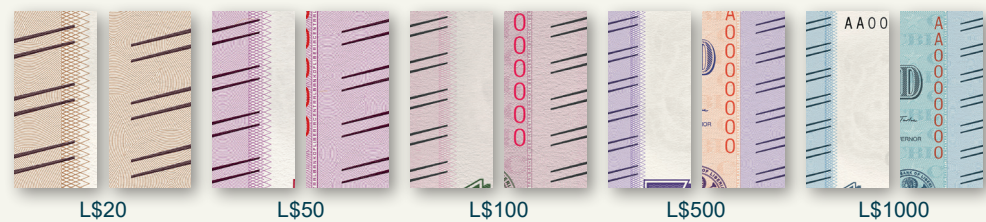
### 4 SEE-THROUGH FEATURE

The see-through feature shows fragments of the Liberian star on the front and back. When the note is held up to the light, the front and back patterns result in a complete image of the “Liberian star”.



### 5 FEATURE FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED

To aid the visually impaired, raised ink on the sides of the banknote can be felt when running your fingers over the edges of the banknote to distinguish between different denominations.



### 6 MICRO-TEXT

Microtext is visible under magnifying glass.
