### Duties and responsibilities include, but not limited to, the following:

Monitoring the performance of key macroeconomic indicators in the 4 sectors of the economy and review price and exchange rate developments; designing survey instruments and leading research analysts to collect both quantitative and qualitative data intended to build historical database as well as analyze those data originating from the four sectors; modeling and forecasting of data so as to determine their impact on economic development and assess whether there is a need for policy change; assisting with the production and publication of the Economic and Financial Bulletin and other key research papers; and writing briefing notes on activities relating to the sub-regional multilateral organizations, the IMF, the World Bank and the AfDB as may be required. The Economist is expected to periodically write topical papers on key sectoral performance;

#### **Oualifications/Experience**

The Economist must be a holder of Master's Degree in Economics from recognized university with strong background in quantitative analysis with 4 years of data compilation and data management experience; the position holder should have appreciable research competencies and understanding of contemporary research methodology, modeling and forecasting; the candidate is expected to have thorough knowledge in data management with the ability to monitor performance of key macroeconomic fundamentals; Proficiency in Microsoft Office, Excel and PowerPoint is highly desirable; he/she should be confortable in working with Eviews 8.1, Stata and Microfit; show a strong work ethic, professional attitude and good oral & written communication skills.
